Objectives:	Cultivating students' mathematical thinking and developing their fundamental mathematical knowledge and capability have always been a topic actively explored by mathematics teachers. For a long time, mathematics teachers have been working hard to develop different strategies and activities, such as problem-solving and mathematical games, and to explore ways to improve teaching effectiveness both inside and outside the classroom. The aim is to assist students in entering the mathematical world so that students can enjoy learning mathematics and appreciate its beauty. With the development of school curricula and changes in kindergarten education policy, Hong Kong mathematics education has not only emerged from cross-disciplinary developments in recent years, such as STEM education, IT education, and cross-curricular language learning. However, these developments have also raised issues worthy of attention, such as bridging between pre-primary and primary education, and self-directed learning. Teacher is the key to connecting students with the world of mathematics. Hong Kong mathematics teachers are facing many challenges. They have to develop students' mathematical literacy so that the students can understand the world with mathematics. At the same time, they have to cope with the diversities among students in the classroom and changes in the educational environment. The conference aims to provide an interactive platform for various parties in the field, including mathematics teachers in secondary and primary schools as well as kindergartens, to share their theoretical views and practical experiences, thus promoting the professional development in mathematics education.
